

James Carmichael - Annie Smyth

James Carmichael, born in Parkneuk, Dunfermline, Fife on 26 August 1884, son of [John Carmichael and Mary Paton Bain](#).

James is at 1 Blackburn, Dunfermline on the 1891 Census and at 184 Baldridgeburn, Dunfermline on the 1901 Census. His occupation is Tailor (Apprentice).

James is recorded as having been baptised into the Catholic Church in Dublin on 27 November 1906. His address is 73 Manor Street, Dublin.

Annie Smyth, born at 29 Upper Ormond Quay, Dublin on 28 August 1889, daughter of [James Smyth and Catherine Byrne](#).

Annie is at 70 Carrick Street, Glasgow on the 1901 Census and at 45 Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on the 1911 Census. Her occupation is Damask Weaver.

John Carmichael, born at 45 Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on 9 May 1914.

John married Marion Nicholas Kerr (b. Dalziel, Lanarkshire c.1911), daughter of David Kerr, at Brandon Church, Motherwell, Lanarkshire on 16 January 1941.

John died at Law Hospital, Carluke, Lanarkshire on 11 February 1982, age 67. His usual address is 60 Yarrow Crescent, Wishaw, Lanarkshire and his occupation was Police Inspector.

Marion died in Wishaw in 1995, age 84.

James Smyth Carmichael, born at 93 Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on 6 September 1916.

James married Margaret Alan Drysdale (b. Cowdenbeath, Fife c.1914), in Dunfermline on 5 August 1939.

Margaret died in Dunfermline in 1978, age 64.

James died at Balnacraig, Saline, Fife on 3 May 1980, age 63. His usual address is 19 David Street, Dunfermline and his occupation was Security Patrolman.

Alexander Bain Carmichael, born at 93 Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on 29 September 1919.

Alexander married Isabella Douglas (b. Kirkliston, West Lothian c.1922) in Kirkliston in 1944.

Isabella died in Uphall, West Lothian on 14 July 1960, age 38.

Alexander married again, to Annie Barker (b. Kelty, Fife on 1 March 1924) in Kelty in 1965.

Alexander died at 219 Glendevon Park, Winchburgh, West Lothian on 12 October 1973, age 54. His occupation was Insurance Agent.

Annie died in Cowdenbeath, Fife on 10 September 2004, age 80.

Andrew Carmichael, born at 93 Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on 4 March 1922.

Andrew died on 14 March 1922, just 10 days old.

Catherine Byrne Carmichael, born at 93 Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on 14 April 1923.

Catherine married James Dalrymple, Coal Miner, in Dunfermline on 2 June 1944.

Catherine died at Cameron Hospital, Windygates, Fife on 7 February 1974, age 50. Her usual address is 28 McLelland Crescent, Dunfermline.

Mary Paton Bain Carmichael, born at 105 Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on 11 August 1927.

Mary married John Younger Russell (b. 167 Pittencrieff Street, Dunfermline on 10 August 1923), Joiner, son of [Alexander Younger Russell and Jane Ramage](#), in Dunfermline Abbey on 13 August 1948.

John died in Dunfermline in 1989, age 66.

Mary died in Dunfermline in 1996, age 69.

William Patrick Carmichael, born at 93 Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on 19 April 1930.

William married Annie Lyle (b. Culross, Fife c.1930), daughter of Alexander Lyle and Matilda Monaghan in Culross, Fife in 1953.

William died in a road accident on the A83 near the Rest and be Thankful on 15 March 1986, age 55. His usual address is 26 Abbey Street, High Valleyfield, Fife and his occupation is Bricklayer.

Annie died in Dunfermline on 23 June 2012, age 82.

Annie died at 56 Tuke Street, Dunfermline on 24 April 1965, age 75.
