

James Russell - Ann Morris

James Russell, born in Dunfermline, Fife c.1815, son of [Alexander Russell and Jane Wilson](#).

Ann Morris, born in Dunfermline, Fife c.1816, daughter of [Thomas Morris and Aminta Burt](#).

An Agnes Morris was born to Thomas Morris and Aminta Burt in Dunfermline on 2 June 1816. Agnes and Ann are possibly the same person.

James and Ann were proclaimed for marriage in the parish of Dunfermline on 21 December 1839.

James and Ann are in Parkneuk, Dunfermline on the 1841 Census, at 40 Brick Row, Forth Iron Works, Carnock, Fife on the 1851 Census, in Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on the 1861 Census, in Whitemyre, Dunfermline on the 1871 Census and at 43 Blackburn, Dunfermline on the 1881 Census.

Ann is possibly a widow at 181 Baldridgeburn, Dunfermline on the 1891 Census.

CHILDREN

Alexander Russell, born in Dunfermline, Fife on 7 September 1840.

Alexander is in Parkneuk, Fife on the 1841 Census, at 40 Brick Row, Forth Iron Works, Carnock, Fife on the 1851 Census and in Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on the 1861 Census.

Alexander married Jane Pender (b. Dunoon, Argyll c.1840), daughter of James Pender and Jane Alcorn. They were married at 120 Main Street, Wishaw, Lanarkshire on 18 January 1864.

Alexander and Jane are in Rumblingwell, Dunfermline on the 1871 Census, in Dunfermline on the 1881 Census and at 133 Baldridgeburn on the 1891 and 1901 Census.

Alexander died at 133 Baldridgeburn on 13 May 1910, age 69.

John Russell, born in Dunfermline, Fife on 26 August 1842.

John is at 40 Brick Row, Forth Iron Works, Carnock, Fife on the 1851 Census, in Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on the 1861 Census and in Whitemyre, Dunfermline on the 1871 Census.

Thomas Russell, born in Dunfermline, Fife c.1842

Thomas is at 40 Brick Row, Forth Iron Works, Carnock, Fife on the 1851 Census. He is the same age as his brother John, so it is possible that they are twins.

[Arthur Russell](#), born in Dunfermline, Fife on 11 February 1848 and baptised at St. Margaret's United Presbyterian Church, Dunfermline on 23 February 1852.

Arthur is at 40 Brick Row, Forth Iron Works, Carnock, Fife on the 1851 Census and in Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on the 1861 Census.

[Arthur married Jane Younger](#) (b. Dunfermline, Fife on 6 July 1848), daughter of [John Younger and Elizabeth Robertson](#), in Pittencrieff Street, Dunfermline on 13 July 1871.

Arthur and Jane are in Whitemyre, Dunfermline on the 1871 Census and at 152 Pittencrieff Street on the 1881 Census.

Arthur died at 120 Pittencrieff Street on 21 September 1885, age 37.

Jane is at 117 Pittencrieff Street on the 1891 and 1901 Census.

Jane died at 6 Victoria Street, Dunfermline on 12 August 1936, age 88.

Ann Russell, born in Dunfermline, Fife on 11 October 1851 and baptised at St. Margaret's United Presbyterian Church, Dunfermline on 23 February 1852.

Ann is in Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on the 1861 Census and in Whitemyre, Dunfermline on the 1871 Census.

Ann married James Russell (b. Dunfermline, Fife c.1850), son of William Russell and Catherine Farmer Miller, in Whitemyre, Dunfermline on 31 December 1872.

Ann and James are at 1 Dean Street, Edinburgh, Midlothian on the 1881 Census, at 23 Edgar Street, Dunfermline on the 1891 Census and at 75

Brucefield Avenue on the 1901 Census. James's occupation is House Painter.

James died at 12 Abbot Street, Dunfermline on 28 June 1933, age 83.

Ann died at 12 Abbot Street on 7 May 1936, age 85.

Jane Russell, born in Dunfermline, Fife on 7 January 1854 and baptised at St. Margaret's United Presbyterian Church, Dunfermline on 25 January 1854.

Jane is in Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on the 1861 Census and in Whitemyre, Dunfermline on the 1871 Census.

Jane married James Stobie in Dunfermline in 1874.

Jane died in West Fife Hospital, Dunfermline on 14 October 1927, age 72. Her usual residence is Cameron Street, Dunfermline.

James Russell, born in Dunfermline, Fife on 14 July 1856.

James is in Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on the 1861 Census and in Whitemyre, Dunfermline on the 1871 Census.

James married Georgina Kirk (b. Maybole, Ayrshire on 24 August 1859), daughter of William Kirk and Jane Findlay.

James and Georgina are at 38 Golfdrum Street, Dunfermline on the 1881 Census, at 134 Albany Street, Dunfermline on the 1891 Census and in Dewar Street, Dunfermline on the 1901 Census. James's occupation is Tailor.

James died in Edinburgh, Midlothian on 29 January 1936, age 79. His address was 31 Polwarth Gardens, Edinburgh, and he was a retired Music Seller.

DEATHS

James died at 71 Parkneuk, Dunfermline on 2 January 1887, age 72.

Ann died at 220 Baldridgeburn, Dunfermline on 23 March 1894, age 78.
