James Strang, born in East Kilbride, Lanarkshire c.1790, son of <u>James Strang</u> and <u>Janet Baird</u>.

Elizabeth Jamieson, born at Netherton Farm, Eaglesham, Renfrewshire and baptised on 20 October 1799, daughter of <u>William Jamieson and Margaret</u> Martinholm.

James and Elizabeth are at Bonnyton Farm, Eaglesham on the 1841 Census. They are possibly there in 1851 as well, however Bonnyton Farm appears to have been missed off that year's census.

CHILDREN

James Strang, born in Eaglesham, Renfrewshire on 28 March 1820.

James is at Bonnyton Farm on the 1841 Census.

James married Ann Craig (b. Mearns, Renfrewshire c.1827). They were proclaimed for marriage in the parish of Mearns on 14 July 1848.

James and Ann are at Shaw Farm, Mearns on the 1851, 1861, 1871 Census.

James died at Shaw Farm on 24 November 1874, age 54.

Ann died at Shaw Farm on 16 June 1899, age 71.

William Strang, born in Eaglesham, Renfrewshire on 3 August 1822.

William is at Bonnyton Farm on the 1841 Census, and probably in 1851 as well.

William married Jessie Gibb (b. Glasgow, Lanarkshire c.1842), daughter of Robert Gibb and Janet Pender, at 120 Glebe Street, Glasgow on 7 February 1861.

William and Jessie are at Bowhouse Farm, Carmunnock, Lanarkshire on the 1861, 1871 and 1881 Census.

Jessie died at Bowhouse Farm in 1884, age 42.

William is at Bowhouse Farm on the 1891 Census, and at Rainham Lodge, St. Helen's, Essex on the 1901 Census.

William died in West Ham, Essex on 4 Jan 1906, age 83.

A grandson of William, William Strang, later became 1st Baron Strang.

Margaret Strang, born in Eaglesham, Renfrewshire on 21 September 1824.

Margaret died in Eaglesham on 1 July 1828, age 3.

Christopher Strang, born in Eaglesham, Renfrewshire on 5 September 1826.

Christopher is at Bonnyton Farm on the 1841 Census, and probably in 1851 as well.

Christopher married Elizabeth Brown (b. Avondale, Lanarkshire c.1831), daughter of Matthew Brown and Mary Black. They were proclaimed for marriage in the parish of Carmunnock on 23 June 1854 and in the parish of Eaglesham on the same day.

Christopher and Elizabeth are at West Tofts Farm, Eaglesham on the 1861 Census and at Redbog Farm, Baldernock, Stirlingshire on the 1871 Census.

Christopher died at Redbog Farm on 26 August 1873, age 46.

Elizabeth is at Redbog Farm on the 1881 and 1891 Census, and died there on 27 January 1900, age 69.

Janet Strang, born in Eaglesham, Renfrewshire on 10 May 1828.

Janet is at Bonnyton Farm on the 1841 Census.

Janet married William Steven (b. Eaglesham, Renfrewshire c.1817), son of William Steven and Janet Crawford. They were proclaimed for marriage in the parish of Eaglesham on 13 June 1850.

Janet and William are at Mid Borland Farm, Eaglesham on the 1851, 1861 and 1871 Census.

Janet, now widowed, is at Mid Borland Farm on the 1881 and 1891 Census and at Croft House, Montgomery Street, Eaglesham on the 1901 Census.

Janet died at Hilton Farm, Whitsome, Berwickshire on 18 November 1903, age 75. Her usual address is 150 Sinclair Drive, Langside, Glasgow.

Margaret Strang, born in Eaglesham, Renfrewshire on 9 July 1831.

Margaret is at Bonnyton Farm on the 1841 Census, and possibly in 1851 as well.

Margaret married James Craig (b. Eaglesham, Renfrewshire c.1824). They were proclaimed for marriage in the parish of Eaglesham on 10 June 1852.

Margaret and James are at Floors Farm, Eaglesham on the 1861, 1871, 1881 and 1891 Census, and at Floors Cottage on the 1901 Census.

James died in Renfrewshire on 20 April 1901, age 77.

Margaret died at Drumkinnon Fram, Alexandria, Dunbartonshire on 22 February 1917, age 85.

Elizabeth Strang, born in Eaglesham, Renfrewshire c.1834.

Elizabeth is at Bonnyton Farm on the 1841 Census and possibly in 1851 as well.

Elizabeth married John McGregor (b. Saltcoats, Ayrshire c.1824), son of William McGregor and Catherine Currie, at Bowhouse Farm, Carmunnock on 13 November 1857. John's occupation is Muslin Manufacturer.

John and Elizabeth are at Cathkin Cottage, Carmunnock on the 1861 Census, in James Street, Helensburgh, Dunbartonshire on the 1871 Census and at "Bonnyton", Upper Sutherland Crescent, Helensburgh on the 1881 Census.

Elizabeth died at Bonnyton on 3 October 1884, age 50.

John is at Bonnyton on the 1891 Census.

Helen Strang, born in Eaglesham, Renfrewshire c.1840.

Helen is at Bonnyton Farm on the 1841 Census, and possibly in 1851 as well.

<u>Helen married John Johnston</u> (b. East Kilbride, Lanarkshire c.1828), son of <u>Alexander Johnston and Agnes Dick</u>.

Helen and John are at 22 Caledonia Road, Govan, Lanarkshire on the 1861 Census, at Roseholm Farm, Dreghorn, Ayrshire on the 1871 and 1881 Census and at Chapelside Farm on the 1891 and 1901 Census.

John died at Chapelside Farm on 18 September 1906, age 79.

Helen is at Chapelside Farm on the 1911 Census.

Helen died at Chapelside Farm on 15 July 1916, age 76.

John Strang, born in Eaglesham, Renfrewshire c.1841.

John is at Bonnyton Farm on the 1841 Census, and possibly in 1851.

John is at Bowhouse Farm, Carmunnock on the 1861 Census.

John married Mary White (b. Douglas, Lanarkshire on 1 April 1839), daughter of Thomas White and Janet Frazer, at Townhead Farm, Monkton, Ayrshire on 19 November 1867.

John and Mary are at Hobsland Farm, Monkton and Prestwick, Ayrshire on the 1871 Census, at Crossveggate Farm, New Kilpatrick, Stirlingshire on the 1881 and 1891 Census, at Claypit Farm, Cardington, Bedfordshire on the 1901 and at Home Farm, Cardington on the 1911 Census.

Mary died on 21 September 1918, age 79.

John died at Cardington, 21 Cessnock Terrace, Troon, Ayrshire on 27 June 1932, age 91.

DEATHS

Elizabeth possibly died before 1855 as her death does not appear to be recorded in the statutory registers.

James died at Bowhouse Farm, Carmunnock, Lanarkshire on 7 December 1860, age 70.
