

Walter McIlquham - Marion Williamson

Walter McIlquham and **Marion Williamson**'s parents and dates and places of birth are unknown.

Marion is the name given on her daughter Mary's record of death, but the Old Parish Records have her name as May, as do the records of all her other children.

Walter and May were proclaimed for marriage in the parish of Baldernock, Stirlingshire on 19 August 1786.

CHILDREN

James McIlquham, born in Baldernock, Stirlingshire and baptised on 24 April 1787.

James possibly married Janet Jarvie, emigrated to Canada and died there in 1864.

May McIlquham, born in Baldernock, Stirlingshire on 30 December 1788.

As with her mother, May is also known as Marion.

May married Ralph Kerr. They were proclaimed for marriage in the parish of Baldernock on 10 July 1812.

May and Ralph are at Low Carbarns Farm, Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire on the 1841 and 1851 Census.

Ralph died at Low Carbarns Farm on 8 August 1851, age 76.

May is in Meadow Vale, Partick, Lanarkshire on the 1861 and 1871 Census.

May died on 28 March 1873, age 84.

Robert McIlquham, born in Baldernock, Stirlingshire and baptised on 14 July 1793.

John McIlquham, born in Baldernock, Stirlingshire on 27 December 1795.

John died in Baldernock on 22 December 1840, age 44.

Walter McIlquham, born in Baldernock, Stirlingshire on 16 August 1798.

Walter married Janet Allan. They were proclaimed for marriage in Glasgow on 10 September 1824.

Walter married again, to Janet Hay. They were proclaimed for marriage in Barony, Lanarkshire on 24 January 1847.

Walter and Janet are at 3 St Nicholas Place, Glasgow on the 1851 Census. Walter's occupation is Contractor and Farmer, employing seven labourers.

Walter died on 15 December 1854, age 56.

Alexander McIlquham, born in Baldernock, Stirlingshire and baptised on 1 February 1801.

Mary McIlquham, born in Baldernock, Stirlingshire and baptised on 26 June 1803.

[Mary married John Frood](#) (b. Lesmahagow, Lanarkshire c.1801), son of [Alexander Frood and Ann Wilson](#).

Mary and John are at Old Kirk Cottage, Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire on the 1841 and 1851 Census and at Cartside Farm, Cathcart, Renfrewshire on the 1861 Census.

On the 1871 Census, Mary is in Meadow Vale, Partick, Lanarkshire and John is at Cartside Farm.

Mary died in Clyde Street, Partick, Lanarkshire on 24 January 1872, age 68.

John died at East End Farm, East Kilbride, Lanarkshire on 1 December 1880, age 78.

DEATHS

Marion died on Baldernock, Stirlingshire on 17 March 1822.

Walter died in Baldernock, Stirlingshire on 21 December 1832.
